Addisalem Bizowork is a painter based in Addis Ababa. Her paintings tell serene stories about everyday life in Ethiopia. Bizowork's vibrant canvases effortlessly combine sophisticated pictorial strategies with the tradition of decorative painting specific to her native country.

Project description:

To Live is a series of small oil paintings that combine text and image. Invested with the Ethiopian Christian painting tradition, Bizowork's recent production is about her authentic urban way of life tested against billboards and graffiti in contemporary Addis Ababa. She uses the Ethiopic calendar to sign her work, according to which the current year is 1999.
